Natural Resource Conservation Planner
Fillmore, Utah

The Millard Conservation District has an opening for the position of a Natural Resource Conservation Planner. This position will be based out of the Fillmore Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) office and will be managed by the local conservation districts.

Preference may be given to local candidates; however, all are encouraged to apply.

The successful applicant will provide technical assistance to the conservation district cooperators, on private and state lands in developing and writing plans for conservation projects and practices to reduce soil erosion, enhance irrigation efficiency, and improve water quality.

The employee will also assist interested conservation districts in providing technical assistance to local cities and counties by using NRCS Soil Surveys, collecting important resource data and providing Geographical Information Systems (GIS), databases and maps for land use planning and evaluation of development proposals.

The position will require education or experience, which includes knowledge of natural resource management and some general agricultural practices along with some methods and techniques as applied to soil and water conservation. The applicants should have a good understanding and background in natural resource conservation and the ability to work with the agricultural community.

Best qualified individuals for this job will have obtained or are working towards a degree in Agronomy, Soil Science, Botany, Horticulture, Agricultural Education, or other natural resource management degrees. On the job training is provided.

This is a full-time entry-level position with a beginning salary in the ***\$43,000.00 to \$45,000*** range: ***depending on experience and capabilities.***

The position also includes health and dental insurance and a retirement plan.
