ZEC Meetings Provide Platform for Fire Talks



The second round of Zone Executive Committee (ZEC) meetings were held in Zones 1, 2, 4, and 5. Zone 5's call stood out for addressing urgent fire concerns. District supervisors emphasized the need for better coordination during controlled burns and wildfires, and are considering a fire management resolution. They also asked UACD to draft a fire-related letter for elected officials that the districts can personalize and send as a district or an individual.

ZEC meetings follow each UACD Board meeting and bring together UACD Board members, UCC representative, Resource Coordinators, CD Chairs and UACD staff through Zoom or phone. UACD Zone Directors share board updates, while districts share local needs and successes. These meetings help districts coordinate, collaborate, and ensure their voices are heard at the state level.


